Comrades,

This will be my final report as Commander of the VFW, Department of Pacific Areas.

We have finished off the year in high gear, with 17 Posts reaching 100% membership, along with 5 Districts. And there are a few more that I think will reach the goal before June 30th. SVC Stein has reported his All-State status in his report, and congratulations to those reaching that level. I would like to give kudos to those Posts and Districts that are in position to hit All-American. I will concentrate on those with a really good shot at reaching it. For Districts, D5 is currently in 5th, with the cutoff for Districts being 10. D2 is at #10, but not all of those ahead of them are qualified for AA status. D3 is at number 7, but they need 41 more members to reach 100%, very doable. And D7 at #7, pretty solid. For Posts, 1054 is



at #5, with the Post level cutoff being 25. They are in great shape. 8180 is at #20, but needs 35 more members. 12147 is at #19, so they need to keep an eye on the standings. 9951 is at #23, and really need to keep an eye on things. 12146 is #18. Post 124 is in good shape at #13 with 2485 at #14. Post 11447 is at #28, and some work to do. Remember, these standings are in their respective divisions. And of course, our great Department is currently sitting at #2, 100.30% and will make All-American. Well done to everyone who contributed in this effort.

I have had my share of highlights this year. The turnaround in Okinawa will rank high on this list. Thank you Comrades! You have come a long way since my visit in October. And since we had no convention this year, the C of A in Cambodia, needs to be mentioned. We all had a great time, and my first visit there will not be my last. Fortunately, in the VFW, what matters most happens in our Posts. This becomes obvious when we look at the number of All-State Posts and Districts our Department has this year, despite the virus; and the fact that we reached over 100% in membership for the sixteenth year in a row.

This month Department will be unveiling a new website. Department and National programs for


