All State Program Department of Pacific Areas 2022-23



The All State Program yearly recognizes those high performing Districts and Posts within the Department of Pacific Areas (DPA) and their support of the DPA and National Programs.

Districts and Posts meeting all requirements by 15 April 2023 will be recognized at the DPA Convention in June 2023. Those not meeting all requirements until after 15 April 2023 will have until 30 June 2023 to meet all requirements will be recognized at the DPA Council of Administration (C of A) in December 2023.

All State District Commander

- District Quartermasters must be bonded in accordance with National By Laws.
- District and all Posts within the District must have successfully completed a DPA inspection.
- District must reach 100% in membership by 30 June 2023 as posted in National MEMSTATS (or 15 April 2023 for recognition at the DPA Convention if an in person event).
- District must have submitted all quarterly Audit results for the quarters of June, September, December, and March to the DPA Quartermaster
 Watson <u>qmdpa@vfwpacific.org</u> by the quarterly due date. Each quarterly audit is due no later than the first day of the month following the due date of the Audit. Audit submission due dates are as follows:

Apr - Jun - perform by 30 September and due to Department by 01 October 2022 Jul - Sep - perform by 31 December and due to Department by 01 January 2023 Oct - Dec - perform by 31 March and due to Department by 01 April 2023 Jan - Mar - perform by 30 June and due to Department NLT 30 June 2023

- All audit results must be in the DPA Quartermaster's inbox NLT 30 June 2023 District must participate in the Voice of Democracy (VOD), Patriots Pen (PP) by submitting at least one entry per program to the DPA VOD/PP Chairman Gley for judging. In lieu of this requirement, the District may elect to send a \$100 donation per program to the VFW National Director of Programs for each program they do not participate in using the link: https://heroes.vfw.org/page/22950/donate/1. After donating, report the donation to the DPA VOD/PP/TA Chairman Gley vdppdpa@vfwpacific.org.
- District must donate a minimum of \$50 to the National Veterans and Military Support (VMS) Program. The donation shall be made via the link: <u>https://heroes.vfw.org/page/22950/donate/1</u>. After donating, report the donation to the DPA VMS Chairman Kelley <u>mapdpa@vfwpacific.org</u>.

District must donate a minimum of \$50 to the National Home and report that donation to the DPA National Home Chairman Himes nhcdpa@vfwpacific.org.

All State Post Commander

- The Post must be 100% in membership by the end of June 2023 as posted in National MEMSTATS (or 15 April 2023 for recognition at the DPA Convention if an in person event).
- Post Quartermaster must be bonded.
- Post must have successfully completed the DPA Inspection.
- Post must have an appointed Service Officer.
- District must have submitted all quarterly Audit results for the quarters of June, September, December, and March to the DPA Quartermaster
 Watson <u>qmdpa@vfwpacific.org</u> by the quarterly due date. Each quarterly audit is due no later than the first day of the month following the due date of the Audit. Audit submission due dates are as follows:

Apr - Jun - perform by 30 September and due to Department by 01 October 2022

Jul - Sep - perform by 31 December and due to Department by 01 January 2023 Oct - Dec - perform by 31 March and due to Department by 01 April 2023 Jan - Mar - perform by 30 June and due to Department NLT 30 June 2023

- Post must be current in monthly DPA Community Service Reports (CSR). Post must input minimum of 3 CSRs between May 2022 and April 2023. Point of contact is DPA Junior Vice Commander Lutman jvcdpa@vfwpacific.org.
- Post must participate in the Voice of Democracy (VOD), Patriots Pen (PP), by submitting at least one entry per program to the District for judging. In lieu of this requirement, the Post may elect to send a \$75 donation per program to the VFW National Director of Programs for each program they do not participate in using the formstack link: https://heroes.vfw.org/page/22950/donate/1. After donating, report the donation to the DPA VOD/PP/TA Chairman Gley vodppdpa@vfwpacific.org.
- Post must participate in the Buddy Poppy program by purchasing at least one box of Poppies. Point of contact is DPA Quartermaster qmdpa@vfwpacific.org.

Post must donate a minimum of \$75 to the National Veterans and Military Support Program. The donation shall be made via the formstack link: <u>https://heroes.vfw.org/page/22950/donate/1</u>. After donating, report the donation to the DPA VMS Chairman Kelley <u>mapdpa@vfwpacific.org</u>.

Post must donate a minimum of \$50 to the National Home and report that donation to DPA National Home Chairman Himes nhcdpa@vfwpacific.org

Post Commander will attend all District meetings. If unavailable, they will send a Post representative. Examples of Post representatives are: Senior Vice Commander, Junior Vice Commander or Post member in good standing may attend in the Post Commanders absence.

Judging

DPA Senior Vice Commander shall track all Posts and Districts and determine those who have met the minimum criteria. All Districts and Posts that meet the minimum criteria as stated above by 15 April 2023 will be considered for All State recognition at the DPA Convention (if an in person event). All Districts and Posts meeting the minimum criteria by 30 June 2023 will be considered for All State at the DPA C of A in December 2023.

Awards for Districts or Posts named All State by 15 April 2023

District Commanders: Receive All State Caps or **\$50.00 stipend to the VFW Store** and Awards/Installation banquet tickets paid by DPA for winner and a guest.

Post Commanders: Airfare paid to and from Convention from home District. Receive All State Cap or **\$50.00 stipend to the VFW Store** and Awards/Installation Banquet Tickets paid by DPA for winner and one guest. Post Commanders residing in the country hosting the DPA Convention will receive a \$300 stipend to attend.

All State Quartermasters will receive All State Cap or **\$50.00 stipend to the VFW Store** and a \$300 stipend if attending the DPA Convention.

Awards for Additional Districts or Posts named All State by 30 June 2023

District Commanders: Receive All State Caps or **\$50.00 stipend to the VFW Store** and DPA C of A Banquet Tickets paid by DPA for winner and a guest. If no longer a District Commander,

airfare to and from the DPA C of A December 2023 will be paid. A Past District Commander residing in the country hosting the DPA C of A will receive a \$200 stipend if attending.

Post Commanders: Receive Airfare paid to and from the DPA C of A 2023 from home District. Receive All State Cap or **\$50.00 stipend to the VFW Store** and DPA December C of A Banquet Tickets paid by DPA for winner and one guest.

All State Quartermasters will receive All State Cap or **\$50.00 stipend to the VFW Store** and \$200 stipend if attending the DPA C of A in December 2023.

NOTE:

All State District and Post Commanders MUST attend all DPA business meetings (Other than Committee Meetings). Airfare awards are NOT transferable.
