

- Legacy Life Membership Program
- Reporting of Community Service Activities

- Contribution's made to the local community and VFW Programs
- Selection for All-State, All-American recognition and other accolades
- Successful completion of scheduled inspections
- Development of a new program or significant improvement of an existing program
- Meeting or Exceeding the goals set by the Department and National
- Management of Post Finances
- Assistance to Veterans there surviving spouses and children
- Participation and Membership in Non-VFW Organizations and programs
